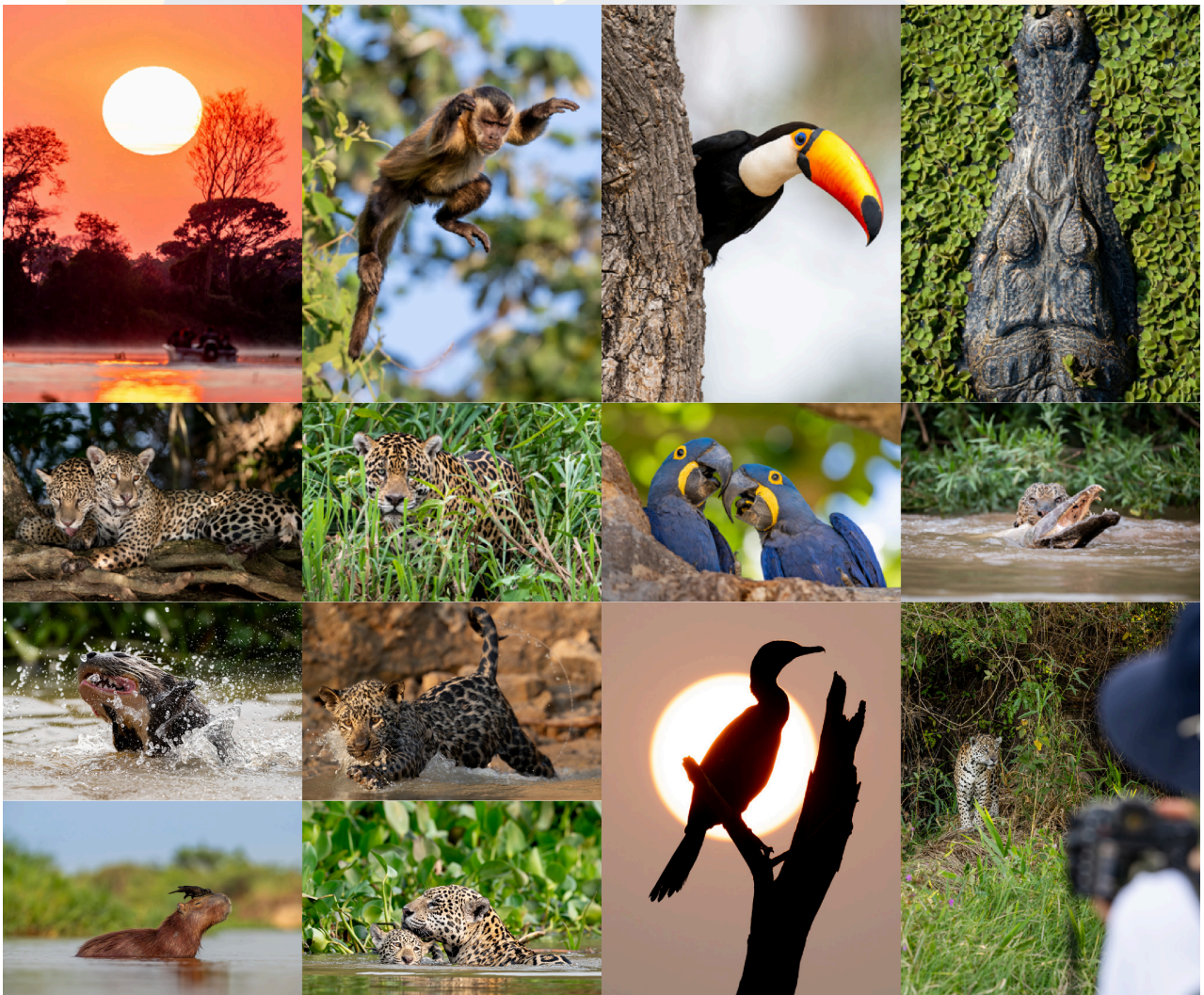

ITINERARY

DAY 1 (Aug 09th)

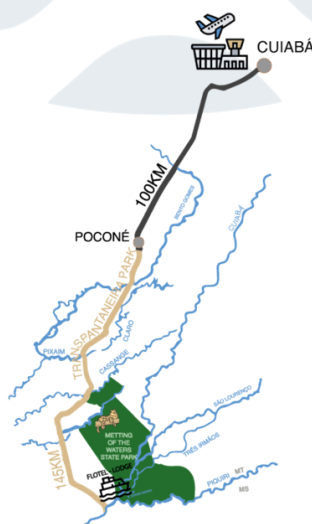

PROGRAM

- You will have the privilege to document a **unique region of the Caatinga**, the only biome exclusively Brazilian located in the semiarid region!
- We will explore the **Serra da Capivara National Park**, the largest open-air museum in the world, the breathtaking landscapes of **Sítio do João Pimenta**, and little-known places in the region (even by locals) like **Esconde**.
- We will also have a powerful immersion into rural communities, including the **Quilombo Lagoas**, capturing their daily lives.



PROGRAM

- This workshop will be conducted in partnership with the NGO **Instituto LUSS**, which has been working for the past five years to **strengthen sustainable development in the communities of the region.**
- The workshop will be led by the **photo-documentarists Tadeu Vilani and Guto Oliveira**, who will make the experience enriching for both beginner and experienced photographers. With their experience in the region, they have carefully selected particularly authentic locations and communities for the activities."



LEADERS



Tadeu Vilani, 60 years old, born in Santo Ângelo, Rio Grande do Sul, is a photo-documentarist with over 25 years of experience. His main influences come from Italian neorealism. He primarily works on documentary projects in the southern region of South America, documenting ethnic formation and social transformations. In 2015, he released the book 'Olhos do Pampa'."

You'll encounter a resilient people, full of life and courage. **The interaction with these individuals will undoubtedly impact your own life.**

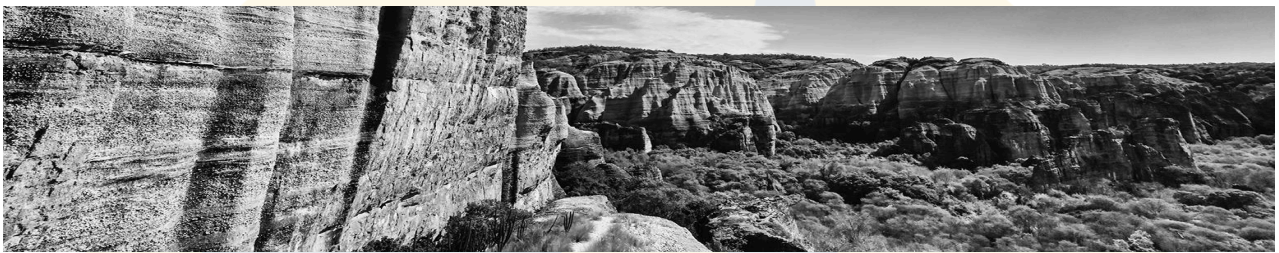

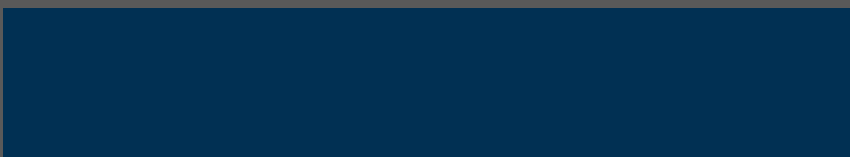

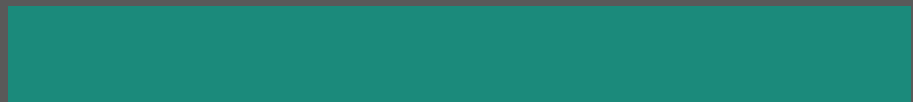

THE EXPERIENCE

Caatinga" is a Tupi-Guarani word that means "white forest", and it's the only biome exclusively Brazilian. This biome covers 10% of the Brazilian territory and is the most populated semi-arid region on the planet, with over 29 million people.

The lack of water is still a major issue for countless families struggling to live in this harsh environment.

Through this workshop, **we aim to shed light on the untold stories** of these resilient people and the unique ecosystem they inhabit.

The Caatinga, with its arid beauty, **becomes a metaphor**, both for the resilience and survival of this incredible people.

Salvador & Praia do Forte | Brazil
8 Days / 7 Nights

SALVADOR

Salvador, the capital of the state of Bahia in northeastern Brazil, is known for its Portuguese colonial architecture, Afro-Brazilian culture, and tropical coastline. The Pelourinho district is its historic heart, with cobblestone streets leading to large squares, colorful buildings, and baroque churches such as São Francisco, famous for its richly gilded woodwork.

Visit landmarks such as **Forte Santo Antônio da Barra**, **Farol da Barra**, **Corredor da Vitória**, **Campo Grande Square** (one of the city's Carnival circuits), **Avenida Sete de Setembro**, and **Municipal Square**, which offers panoramic views of the Lower City, including the **Elevador Lacerda**, commercial district, Port of Salvador, and **Mercado Modelo**.

Farol da Barra, Avenida Sete de Setembro, passing through Ladeira da Barra, Largo da Vitória (home to one of the oldest churches in Bahia), Corredor da Vitória, and Campo Grande.

The walking tour begins at Municipal Square, where the Rio Branco Palace and City Hall are located, facing the Elevador Lacerda. From there, visit the Cathedral Basilica of Salvador and the Church of São Francisco, followed by Pelourinho Square.

Dique do Tororó with the sculptures of the Candomblé orixás, Fonte Nova Stadium, Vale de Nazaré Avenue, passage to the Lower City through the Américo Simas Tunnel, Caminho de Areia Avenue, Bonfim Hill, passing by Monte Serrat Fort with views of All Saints Bay, the Sanctuary of Saint Dulce, and a stop at Mercado Modelo.

TOUR ITINERARIES

SALVADOR

- Salvador is one of the most beautiful and visited cities in Brazil, offering attractions for all tastes: beaches and natural beauty, historical landmarks related to the beginning of Brazilian colonization, music, traditional cuisine, spirituality, and capoeira. It is home to the world's largest Carnival and is widely known as the "Capital of Joy," welcoming visitors from around the world with warmth and hospitality.

HISTORIC BAHIA TOUR

- The tour begins at Farol da Barra, the geographical boundary between All Saints Bay and the Atlantic Ocean, with a photo stop. Along Avenida Sete de Setembro, pass by Ladeira da Barra (home to the Yacht Club, Santo Antônio da Barra Church, and the English Cemetery), Largo da Vitória, Corredor da Vitória, and Campo Grande. The walking tour starts at Municipal Square, where the Rio Branco Palace and City Hall are located, facing the Elevador Lacerda, offering one of the most beautiful views of All Saints Bay. Continue to Terreiro de Jesus, home to the Cathedral Basilica of Salvador, and visit the Church of São Francisco, considered one of the richest churches in Brazil and the finest example of Portuguese Baroque architecture in the world. The tour ends at Pelourinho Square, a UNESCO World Heritage Site immortalized by writer Jorge Amado.

PANORAMIC BAHIA TOUR

- The tour begins at Farol da Barra, followed by a visit to Dique do Tororó, with sculptures of the Candomblé orixás and views of the Fonte Nova Stadium. Continue along Vale de Nazaré Avenue, reach the Lower City through the Américo Simas Tunnel, pass through the port area and the Calçada commercial district, and follow Caminho de Areia Avenue.
- Stop at Bonfim Hill for photos at Salvador's most famous church, known for the traditional "Lavagem do Bonfim." Pass by Monte Serrat Fort, offering stunning views of All Saints Bay, then stop at the Sanctuary of Saint Dulce. The tour includes a stop at Mercado Modelo to experience local handicrafts, music, and atmosphere.

BAHIA BY NIGHT (FOLKLORIC SHOW + DINNER)

Departure at 7:00 p.m. – Return at 10:00 p.m.

- Includes transfer, guide, dinner, and folkloric show featuring Afro-Bahian cultural expressions such as samba de roda, fishermen's dance, maculelê, capoeira, dances of the orixás, and Candomblé rhythms. Beverages not included.

- Travel along the Coconut Road toward Bahia’s North Coast, visiting beaches along Avenida Oceânica and Itapuã. Visit Praia do Forte, known as the “Brazilian Polynesia,” including Projeto Tamar and the charming fishing village. Swimming time at Guarajuba Beach, known for calm, crystal-clear waters. Optional lunch featuring traditional Bahian cuisine.

ISLAND TOUR (FRADES & ITAPARICA)

Departure at 8:00 a.m. – Return at 5:30 p.m.

- Transfer from hotel to pier and embarkation on a schooner equipped with sound system, bar, and guide. Navigate All Saints Bay with stops at Frades Island and Itaparica Island. Enjoy swimming in crystal-clear waters and optional lunch with traditional Bahian cuisine.

Lençóis Maranhenses | Brazil

LENÇÓIS MARANHENSES

Covering more than 156,000 hectares of protected area, **Lençóis Maranhenses National Park** dominates the northeastern region of Brazil.

São Luís, the capital of Maranhão, has many unique characteristics: it is the only Brazilian city founded by the French and holds the largest collection of Portuguese tiles in Latin America. In the Historic Center, the façades of colonial mansions decorated with delicate tiles imported from Portugal offer a journey back in time.

The **Palácio dos Leões**, residence of the state governor, features French art and furniture. Nearby stands the impressive **Palácio La Ravardière**, dating back to the 17th century. Known as the “Island of Love,” São Luís also has a modern side, represented by the lively **Avenida dos Holandeses** and the bars around the charming **Lagoa da Jansen**.

Santo Amaro is the first municipality within the Lençóis Maranhenses region and shelters picturesque landscapes among white sand dunes, such as the village of **Betânia**, inhabited by traditional coastal communities living near beautiful freshwater lagoons.

Barreirinhas is the main gateway to the National Park. Walk through dunes and sandy trails, where white sand dunes reaching up to 50 meters high meet blue-green lagoons with crystal-clear waters. The most famous lagoons are **Lagoa Azul** and **Lagoa Bonita**. Swimming in the lagoons, walking on the sand, and watching the sunset are unforgettable experiences. Adventures include quad bike rides through the dunes of the “Pequenos Lençóis,” reaching the deserted **Caburé Beach**, boat rides along the **Preguiças River**, and a visit to the **Mandacaru Lighthouse**, offering one of the most beautiful views in the region.

THE VILLAGE OF ATINS

The bucolic village of Atins, one of the gateways to the tropical desert of Lençóis Maranhenses, enchants visitors with its simple lifestyle, sandy streets, rustic houses surrounded by dunes, mangroves, cashew trees, and coconut palms.

Activities are unique and set amid breathtaking scenery, including horseback riding, 4x4 excursions, quad biking, and kitesurfing on the river or lagoons.

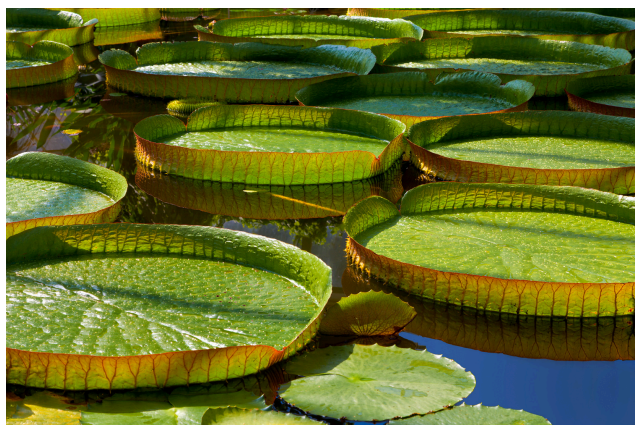
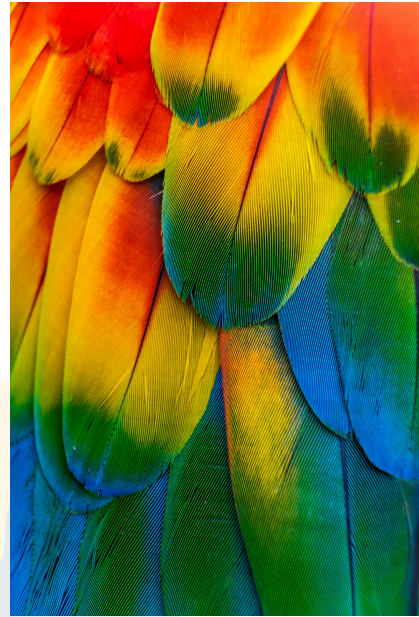

Brazilian Iguazu Falls

- One of the most impressive natural wonders in the world, set within a magical landscape. The contrast between lush green vegetation, dark basalt rocks, and the powerful white waters creates a breathtaking visual experience and a deep sense of connection with nature. The visit is made via well-marked walkways that are carefully integrated into the landscape.

Macuco Safari – Boat Tour

The tour begins with a guided electric jeep ride through the subtropical forest, followed by a walk along suspended walkways, leading to a twin-engine boat that navigates the river rapids up to the base of the waterfalls. 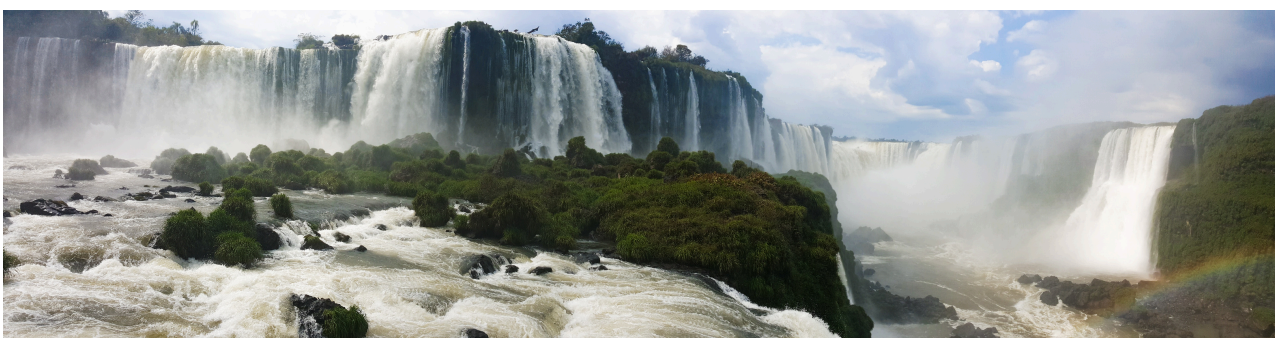
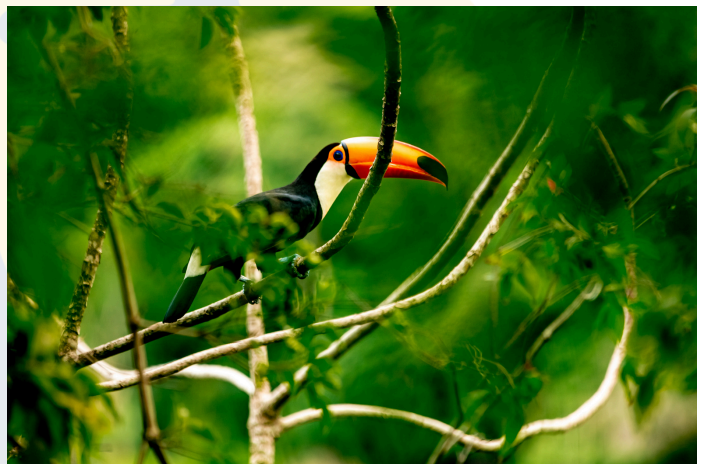
